

LARAMIE COUNTY GENERAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION

The Clerk of Laramie County, in accordance with the Secretary of State, and as directed by Federal and State mandates, proclaims that November 6, 2018, is the day of the General Election to fill various and prescribed United States, State of Wyoming, District, Laramie County and City of Cheyenne public offices.

All residents of Laramie County who are 18 years of age or older on or before November 6, 2018 and if not registered, are encouraged to register to vote on or before October 22, 2018 and participate in this election. Acceptable identification is required to register. Residents may register at the polls on Election Day. Absentee voting begins September 21, 2018 and ends November 5, 2018

Vote Centers will open at 7 A.M. on November 6, 2018, and will remain open until 7 P.M. on that date. The Vote Centers shall be as follows:

In addition to the offices previously published in the Laramie County Primary Election Proclamation, the following ballot propositions will be submitted to the voters of Laramie County:

Laramie County Community College: Shall Laramie County Community College District be authorized to levy and additional one (1) mill on the assessed value of the District (Laramie County) for the purpose of renovating and expanding educational facilities as allowed by state law? The one (1) mill would be in effect for four (4) years and is necessary in order for LCCC to receive \$7 million in state funding currently authorized by the legislature. Without this one (1) mill levy, the \$7 million in funding from the legislature will be lost.

Laramie County 1% Sales and Use Tax: "Shall the Laramie County Commissioners be authorized to renew a one percent (1%) sales and use tax within the county as authorized by state statute W.S. 39-15-204; The revenue to be used as general revenue?"

Laramie County Lodging Tax: "Shall Laramie County be authorized to renew a lodging tax at a rate of four percent (4%) upon the sales price paid for sleeping accommodations for guests hotels, motels, tourist courts, trailer parks, campgrounds, dude ranches, short-term condominiums and similar establishments, in accordance with W.S. 39-15-204(a)(ii)?"
